Guidelines and Process for Academic Recovery Summer 2019

Summer Course Requests are entered for eligible students (see [Aeries Video: Summer Course Requests](#)).
There are NO application forms. Last date to enter Summer Course Requests is **April 15, 2019.**

Parental permission forms are essential and no student will be admitted to summer school without signed parent/student consent forms ([Summer 2019 ER Contact and Permission Form](#)).

Bootcamp and Intervention programs: Enter Summer Course Requests by May 3, 2019.

Please do not email the AR staff regarding student drops or late senior registration requests.

Student drops can be made after May 3rd on the [Academic Recovery Student Drop Form](#).

Use the [Late Summer AR Senior Registration Request Form](#) after May 3rd to request late registration for Seniors who earned a D or F during Spring 2019.

Guide for Student Eligibility

- ❑ Seniors who are eligible for summer 2019 graduation and/or are not more than 20 credits deficient.
- ❑ Seniors have priority, then 11th graders and finally 10th graders are placed if there is room available.
- ❑ Students MUST have a D or F grade in the subject on their transcript in Aeries at time of application.
- ❑ Students are not eligible for original credit in summer (please see below for exceptions).
 - Failed AP and Honors courses are not eligible to be recovered in summer school. Students can enroll in a regular course to make up credits for the AP or Honors course. For example, if a student failed AP English Language Arts in their 11th grade year, the student can enroll in English 3 during the summer to make up their junior year English requirement. A repeat tag will not be applied.
- ❑ Please do not enter Summer Course Requests for students who do not have a D or an F on an *OUSD* transcript. Seniors who have recently transferred and are not more than 20 credits deficient will be considered eligible as long as the student has a transcript that has been evaluated and entered in Aeries. The AR office does not translate out-of-district transcripts.
- ❑ SDC classes: SDC classes are not offered during Academic Recovery. Please contact Programs for Exceptional Children (PEC) regarding extended school year opportunities.
- ❑ Please be mindful about placing students with IEP accommodations in a summer school class because we cannot guarantee that those accommodations will be met. Consult with IEP/SpEd coordinator or the appropriate personnel.
