2019 Academic Recovery Summer School Agreement/Consent Form

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- The deadline for applying for the 2019 Academic Recovery Summer School program is April 15, 2019.
- 2019 Academic Recovery Summer School is located at: **Oakland High School**
- 2019 Academic Recovery Summer School is designed for academic recovery and is an opportunity for students to make-up D's and F's.
- Late registration is ONLY for Seniors who need to make up a D or F grade earned in the Spring 2019 school term. Contact your school counselor.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Students are **expected** to attend class **every day** in order to meet the minimum time necessary to earn five credits for each class.
- 2019 Academic Recovery Summer School program will be held from: Monday, June 10, 2019 until Wednesday, July 10, 2019. Students **MUST** attend the first day of summer school in order to guarantee their place in summer.
- Thursday, July 4th is a holiday; summer school will be closed.
- The hours are from 8:30am to 2:00 pm daily (Monday-Friday).
- 1st period/Fall term classes: 8:30-11:00 am. 2nd period/Spring term classes: 11:30 am-2:00 pm.
- **Transportation to/from Summer School is the responsibility of students/families.**
- All school material loaned, such as books, supplies, etc., **must be returned or paid for** if lost or damaged before grades are recorded onto student transcripts.
- All students are provided meals throughout summer school - Breakfast is at 8am, Lunch is at 11am.

ATTENDANCE

- **Students will be dropped from the program on their 3rd absence. There are no excused absences under any circumstances.**
- **Students absent from any course on the last day of Summer School, Wednesday, July 18, 2018 will not receive credit for that course. Final exams will be given on that day.**
- **Tardies greater than 15 minutes in length will be treated as an absence. There are no excused tardies.**
- Two tardies are the equivalent of one absence.

STUDENT CONDUCT

- Students are expected to maintain the appropriate behavior required during the school year. Inappropriate attitude or behavior will result in dismissal from the Academic Recovery Summer School program.
- Dismissal may occur on the first incident or occurrence. The Academic Recovery Summer School Principal will have the final say in all dismissals. Dismissals may not be appealed. All policies and rules of OUSD will be in effect.
