In Home Supportive Services Applicant/Recipient

wants to live in their own home

needs help to stay in their home safely

needs help with cleaning up, cooking, shopping, walking, etc.

In Home Supportive Services Social Worker

explains program rules

interviews people in their homes or on the phone

asks very personal questions

writes reports that explain why the client needs or doesn't need services

reviews California Department of Social Services Guidelines

In Home Supportive Services Social Work Supervisor

trains social workers

attends meetings

reviews reports

observes interviews
